Carers' Group Meeting

Emma attended the meeting in order to inform PPG members about the carers' group and to ask for volunteers to be involved in setting up the next meeting.

There has been a Carers' group at CLMP for 7 years. Carers must be registered at the Practice. They are sent a Welcome Letter and offered a free seasonal flu and covid jab and health check. Pre-covid 60 carers were identified, post-covid 120.

Emma pointed out that not all carers recognised that they were carers, particularly those caring for family loved ones. She said that the take up of invitations to the annual Carers' Event was disappointing. She would like to re establish the event, which usually lasts about 2 hours, and would welcome working alongside PPG members. Emma hopes that PPG members would provide ideas and support for planning and would also attend. Representatives from the Carers' Trust and Dementia Awareness have attended previous events. There was opportunity for discussion, sharing of ideas and the possibility to talk confidentially.

- A CQC inspection is imminent. The last inspection, in which the PPG participated, was in 2016 with a more recent telephone inspection.
- following a blood test when discussion with the GP is required the GP will contact the patient rather than the patient having to contact the surgery.

- The surgery is undertaking flu vaccinations this year. Many patients have already been contacted to make an appointment and others will be in the near future.
- Covid vaccinations start on September 1st. The Practice is contracted to carry out vaccinations on those who are immune-suppressed, those in care homes and housebound. Others will be contacted but not necessarily by the Practice and there will be a PCN vaccination centre at the Ahmadiyyah Mosque

Website Development

Martin and Sandra have had two meetings with Dr. Hussein, who has started to develop the new look and navigation, has adopted Martin's initial ideas. He has also shared developments with GP partners who are happy with the developments so far. Dr. Hussein is keen to continue to work with the PPG on website development.
